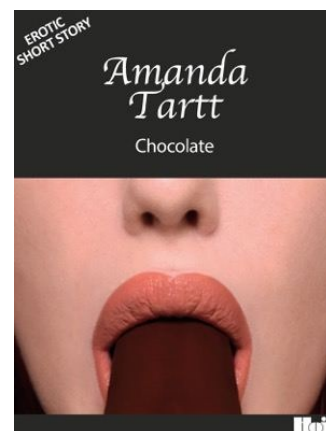
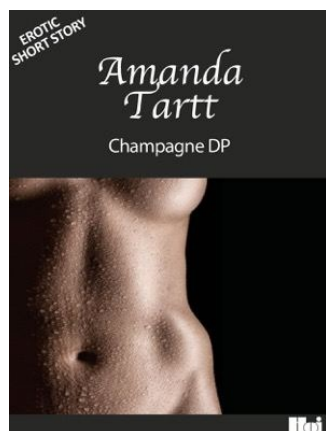




The innovative Swedish publishing house Hoi is now launching its books and short stories on the international scene.
