Polish Military Academy Of Land Forces Orders Tactical Engagement Simulation System

Defence and security company Saab has received the first order, under a two-year agreement recently signed with the General Tadeusz Kosciuszko Military Academy of Land Forces in Wroclaw (WSOWL), Poland, to deliver a high fidelity Tactical Engagement Simulation System (TESS). This initial order will provide the future officers with a proven, off-the-shelf and technically advanced training system which offers unrivalled interoperability options within NATO and beyond, whilst providing the capacity for long-term system growth.

The fully instrumented laser-based TESS capability that will be delivered is drawing on over 35 years of tactical engagement simulation design, delivery and support expertise and a demonstrated track record of delivering on time and on budget, to most countries within NATO. With this system, WSOWL can conduct realistic combat training using small arms and anti-tank weapons laser simulators and evaluate the results of exercises.
