Profitability 2018 is estimated to be lower than previously communicated

Earlier profitability forecast:

The Group's operational profitability (EBITDA) in 2018 is expected to be on last year's level or slightly below, since the commissioning of the Skogn plant has been delayed according to updated information from the general contractor and due to operational disturbances at Södertörn in the beginning of the year.

Updated profitability forecast:

The Group's profitability (EBITDA) 2018 is expected to be lower than last year, since the commissioning of the Skogn plant has been delayed and due to operational disturbances at Södertörn and that the dispute costs have been higher than planned.
