Chief Executive's comments

Group net sales in the first quarter 2015 amounted to 687 MSEK (646), which was an increase with 41 MSEK or 6% compared to last year. It is explained by a positive sales performance in Sweden and Norway but also UK and the US have had a good development. The market development in Finland was continued weak, even if the situation has improved somewhat during the year. The operating profit excluding depreciation and non-recurring items amounted to 76 MSEK (53) or 11.1% (8.2) which was 23 MSEK better than the same period previous year. The improved operating profit was mainly related to higher sales but also to improved gross margin.

The Group's total net sales during first quarter was better than the same period last year due to higher net sales of hardwood flooring, which increased by totally 5%. Also resilient, laminate and tiles had a good development with an increase of 13% while other, particularly flooring accessories, increased by 17% during the first quarter of the year.

Region Nordic developed positively with a strong growth in the main markets Sweden and



Norway. Also Region Americas, Region Russia & CIS and Region Other Markets showed good volume growth during the first quarter. In Region Central Europe, UK showed the strongest growth rate while Germany was declining slightly and Switzerland was somewhat positive compared to the same period last year. In Region Finland & Baltic we saw a continued weak development due to a hesitant project market. However, there is some improvement and an increased activity can be seen in the market.

The gross margin increased from 32.6% to 33.7% which is mainly explained by improvement in product mix, especially in the hardwood flooring segment but also by price increases implemented during the first quarter that has affected the margin positively. The fixed costs are still kept on a moderate level and during the first quarter they were 1% higher than the same period 2014, despite a sales growth of 6%. The operating profit excluding depreciation and non-recurring items was 76 MSEK or 11.1% compared to 53 MSEK or 8.2% the same period last year.

During the first quarter, the Net Working Capital increased with 82 MSEK, which is according to expectations due to seasonal variations both in sales and in purchase of material. Trade receivables have increased with 118 MSEK while trade payables have increased with 21 MSEK. The Group's total inventory was reduced by 15 MSEK.

In February, Kährs Group acquired a minority share of the recently formed Croatian company Pozgaj Flooring to strengthen the supply footprint. Pozgaj Flooring, which was previously part of Pozgaj Group, manufactures wood flooring including saw mill operations. The acquisition adds own production of wood flooring near the important Central European market and secure supply of high-quality Croatian oak to the Group. Kährs Group also has a call option to acquire the remaining shares in the company.

Financial highlights and key ratios

First quarter 2015 in brief

- Net sales amounted to 687 MSEK (646), an increase with 41 MSEK or 6% compared with the previous year.

- The operating profit excluding non-recurring items in the first quarter amounted to 52 MSEK (30) or 7.6% (4.6).
- The profit for the period amounted to 35 MSEK (5) in the first quarter. The explanation for the positive deviation was mainly related to a stronger gross profit due to higher net sales and improved gross margin while the costs were kept at a moderate level.
- In February, a minority share of the recently formed Croatian company Pozgaj Flooring was acquired to strengthen the supply footprint. The acquisition adds own production of wood flooring near the important Central European market and secure supply of high-quality Croatian oak to the Group.

Net sales

First quarter

Total Group net sales amounted to 687 MSEK (646), an increase with 6% compared with 2014.

Operating profit

First quarter

The operating profit (EBIT) for the first quarter amounted to 57 MSEK (30) or 8.3% (4.6), an improvement with 90%. The operating profit excl. non-recurring items (Adj. EBIT) amounted to 52 MSEK (30) or 7.6% (4.6) and the operating result excluding depreciation and non-recurring items (Adj. EBITDA) reached 76 MSEK (53) or 11.1% (8.2).

The profit for the period was 35 MSEK (5) where the improvement is explained by stronger gross profit due to higher net sales and improved gross margin while the costs were kept at a moderate level.

The total depreciation of the Group's fixed assets amounted to 24 MSEK (22) in the quarter.

Net financial cost

First quarter

The net financial cost was -15 MSEK (-24). The costs are mainly related to the corporate bond, but also to interest on the utilized overdraft facility and the shareholder loans from Nanna II S.C.A. in Luxembourg.

Cash flow and Investments

First quarter

Operating cash flow in the first quarter amounted to -12 MSEK (-73). The improvement in result compared to last year affected the operative cash flow positively. At the same time, the Group had a lower increase in net working capital compared to Q1 last year, 82 MSEK (111). This improvement was mainly related to a larger reduction of inventory and higher trade payables than per March 31 previous year. The net working capital was only 1 MSEK higher per 31 March 2015 than the same date previous year, despite a sales growth of 6%.

The investments during the period amounted to 23 MSEK, to be compared with 37 MSEK during first quarter, 2014. The major part of the investments have been made at the production site in Nybro, Sweden and also in Satulung Romania, where the existing operation is expanded to a full scale flooring factory to be completed by the end of 2015.

Financial position

Total assets of the Group amounted to 2,139 MSEK per 31 March 2015 (2,026 MSEK per 31 December 2014) and the Equity ratio was 19% excluding shareholder loans from Nanna II S.C.A (17% per 31 December 2014).

The net debt of the Group, including finance lease amounted to 799 MSEK per 31 March 2015, to be compared with 762 MSEK per 31 December 2014. The Group net debt excl. finance lease amounted to 683 MSEK per 31 March 2015, to be compared with 645 MSEK per December 2014. The net debt, excl. finance lease, in relation to adjusted EBITDA amounted per 31 March to 2.4x and the interest coverage ratio amounted to 5.1x.

Consolidated cash and cash equivalents per 31 March 2015 was 71 MSEK compared to 80 MSEK per 31 December 2014, a decrease of 9 MSEK during the quarter. The Group utilized, per 31 March, 45 MSEK of the agreed bank overdraft facility of 100 MSEK. This means that the available liquidity per 31 March amounted to 126 MSEK for the Group.

Employees

The number of employees in the Group per 31 March 2015 was 1,540, which is an increase of 10 employees since the 31 December 2014. The number of employees outside Sweden per 31 March was 827, which is an increase of 31 employees.

Net sales and result in summary

Net sales

Net sales for the Group amounted to 687 MSEK (646), in the first quarter 2015, an increase with 41 MSEK or 6%.

The major part of the increase in sales, 28 of 41 MSEK, is explained by a positive sales development of hardwood flooring. Also resilient, laminate and tiles increased, with 9 MSEK, and segment Other increased with 4 MSEK compared to the same period last year.

Net sales per product Group

Hardwood flooring sales continued to show a mixed development in the sales regions during the first quarter. The hardwood sales increased with 28 MSEK or 5% compared to the same period last year, to 581 MSEK.

Sales of resilient, laminate and tiles amounted to 78 MSEK in the quarter, which is an increase of 13% compared to the same period 2014. Net sales for segment Other, including flooring accessories, increased by over 17% in the first quarter, to 28 MSEK.

Net Sales by region

The Group had a continued good sales development in Region Nordic during the first quarter where the increase, compared to the same period 2014, was 12%. This increase in sales is mainly explained by a positive development in hardwood flooring in Sweden and Norway, but also by a good development of resilient flooring in the Swedish market. In Central Europe, the growth was 2% where the UK showed the strongest growth rate while Germany was declining slightly and Switzerland was somewhat positive compared to the same period last year.

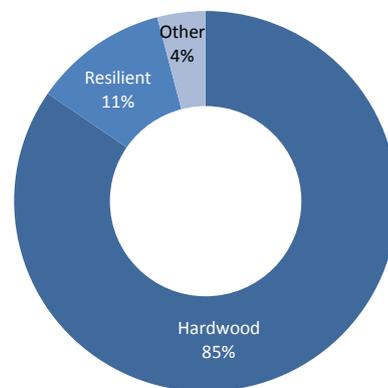
The Region Russia & CIS had a very good volume development during the first quarter and grew by 27%, while at the same time affected by the weak Ruble. However, price increases were implemented in the region from 1 January 2015, which has compensated for parts of the Ruble deterioration.

Also Region Americas as well as Other Markets had a positive development with sales increases of 23% and 19% respectively, in the first quarter. We also

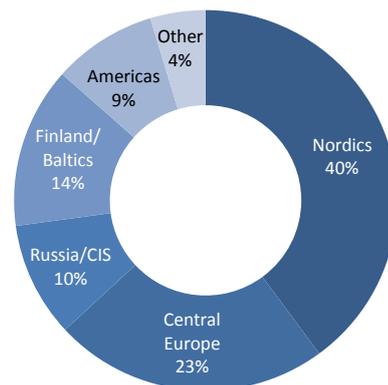
expect a continued improvement in the US market during 2015.

Region Finland & Baltic showed a continued negative sales development during the first quarter of -4%. The project market has been weak also during the initial months of 2015, but we see a trend towards smaller projects being started while the larger projects continue to be hesitant.

Operating result (adjusted EBITDA and EBIT)

The operating result excluding depreciation and non-recurring items (adjusted EBITDA) amounted in the first quarter to 76 MSEK (53) or 11.1% (8.2). Operating result (EBIT) during the first quarter was 57 MSEK (30). The allocation of Group EBIT between product segments is shown in the charts on page 6.

Efficient risk management is an ongoing process conducted within the framework of business controlling, and is a continuing review of the operations and forward-looking assessments of the business.

Kährs long-time risk exposure is not assumed to deviate from the inherent exposure associated with Kährs ongoing business operations.

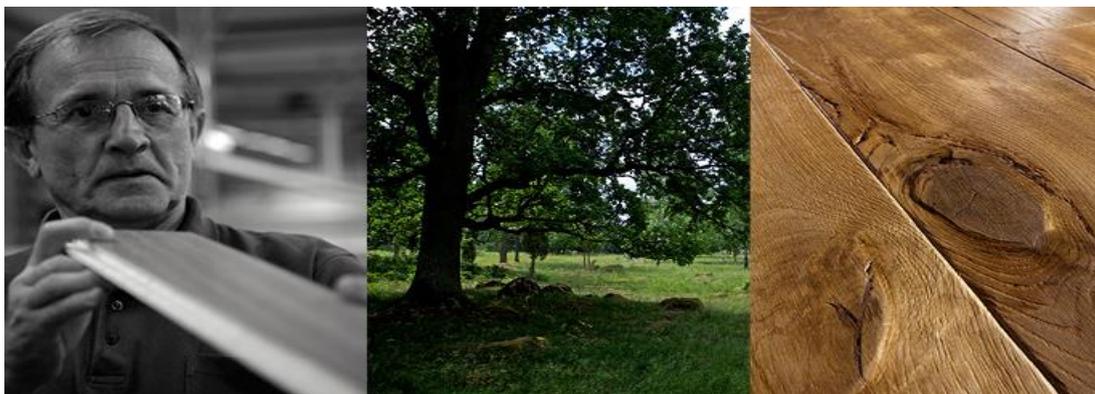
Parent company
