



TELEMUNDO NAMES MEXICAN JOURNALIST JULIO VAQUEIRO CO-ANCHOR OF “NOTICIAS TELEMUNDO FIN DE SEMANA”



MIAMI – October 9, 2017 – Noticias Telemundo announced the addition of the Mexican journalist Julio Vaqueiro as co-anchor of “Noticias Telemundo Fin de Semana.” The move brings Vaqueiro to the national stage after five years as news anchor at Telemundo 52 Los Angeles/KVEA. In his new role, Vaqueiro will join journalist Felicidad Aveleyra at the helm of “Noticias Telemundo Fin de Semana” which airs Saturdays and Sundays at 6:30 PM/5:30 CT.

“Julio Vaqueiro is one of the most talented news anchors I’ve met,” said Luis Fernández, Executive Vice President of Noticias Telemundo. “I have followed his work closely, and his professionalism, rigor, and dedication have been evident every step of the way. I am delighted to have him join our national weekend newscast.”

Vaqueiro co-anchored the news on Telemundo 52 Los Angeles/KVEA, the local Telemundo station, from 2013 through 2017. During the same period, he was also a contributor on the cable news network MSNBC. His first role with Telemundo was as Mexico City correspondent with contributions to “Al Rojo Vivo con María Celeste” and “Noticias Telemundo.”

Before moving to the United States, Vaqueiro was an editor, reporter and news presenter for Efekto TV in Mexico City. He earned a B.A. in communications at Universidad Anáhuac del Norte.
