ASLMS Teams Up with North American Association for Laser Therapy (NAALT)

Wausau, WI – Laser 2013 will include a special session conducted by the North American Association for Laser Therapy (NAALT), Saturday, April 6, as part of the 33rd Annual Conference of the American Society for Laser Medicine & Surgery, Inc. (ASLMS), April 3-7, 2013, Boston, MA.
