"To visit the handful of truly pristine destinations and to experience the contrast between traditional and emerging societies is rare and, in many cases, the opportunities to visit these places remain limited," said MTS President and CEO Kevin Callaghan. "Many destinations such as Eastern Greenland and Madagascar are truly still undiscovered and, while some of the world's most magical and intriguing destinations, such as Myanmar and Bhutan, are slowly becoming more accessible, we are immersed in the hidden corners and our customized adventures and tours are true journeys exploration."

As the first U.S. company to open the doors to commercial trekking in Nepal, MTS continues to write the book on adventure travel. Since their first trek to Everest 45 years ago, MTS has been the leader of expedition cruises in the Galapagos, adventure safaris, and many first descents of classic rivers including Ethiopia's Omo River and the Bio-Bio in Chile. MTS has deeply-rooted, long-term relationships in communities that it visits; for example, MTS has access to rare permits and private wildlife concessions in Africa and Alaska from years of exploring and solidifying relationships. A few of the memorable pioneering adventures include the first U.S. trek to Morocco's Atlas Mountains and the first Serengeti walking safari. Even today, MTS' on-the-ground experts in Tanzania recently received top honors as the Best Walking Safari Company for 2015 in the country.

The year-round calendar of trips range between three days to three weeks, offering profound and moving experiences that fit the interests, budgets and time of today's discerning traveler. Solo travelers can climb Kilimanjaro, multi-generational families can take over a private yacht tour in the Galapagos, and adventurers who want an extreme challenge can trek the Cordillera Blanca in Peru.
