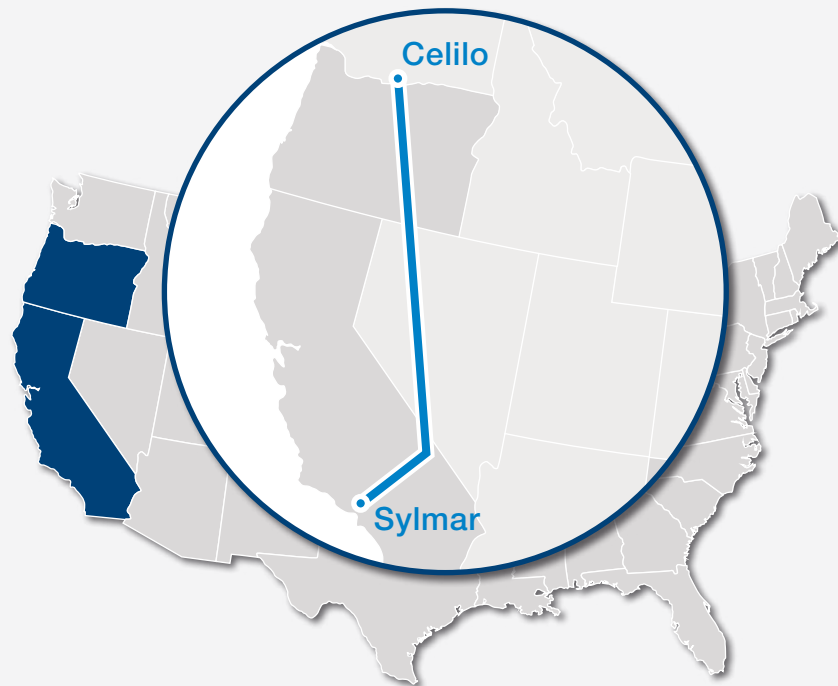


An HVDC line for all seasons

Flexible power flow for up to 3 million houses

The 846 mile (1362 kilometer) long **Pacific HVDC Intertie** allows power to flow between the Northwest and Southern California, helping to balance supply with demand.



Oregon consumes more **power for heating** during winter while in summer California consumes more power **for cooling**.
