

FACT SHEET Most Traded – first six months of 2006

The aim of the Most Traded segment is to highlight the most liquid companies on the Stockholm Stock Exchange's A List. The segment is updated at the end of each half-year. During the first half of 2006, the segment will include a total of 33 companies.

Qualifying rules for inclusion in Most Traded on the Stockholm Stock Exchange's A List

The requirements are that trading in the company's shares during the preceding twelve-month period exceeds SEK six billion (the equivalent of SEK 24 million per day) and that the company, at the end of the calculation period, has a market value exceeding SEK eight billion. The calculation period refers to the preceding twelve months, with May 31 and November 30 as the closing dates. Implementation takes place on the first trading day of each half-year. In special cases, a new company may be included on the Most Traded segment, if it is deemed highly probable that the criteria stipulated above can be fulfilled.
