Victoria Park signs lease with Karlskrona Municipality

Victoria Park has signed a lease with Karlskrona Municipality concerning the leasing of office premises in central Karlskrona adapted to a department in the municipal administration of elderly care. The agreement, which will take effect on 1 April 2019, extends for five years and comprises more than 600 square metres with an annual rent of approximately SEK 800,000.

“We are delighted to offer adapted office premises and an attractive workplace in central Karlskrona for a department in the municipal administration,” says Victoria Park’s COO Ola Svensson.

The premises will be customised for the tenants prior to occupancy, which will be on 1 April 2019. The annual rent is approximately SEK 800,000 and the lease extends for a five-year period.

“In addition to premises adapted to our organisation, our aims and objectives, the move will entail a new beginning for our entire operation,” says Carina Thörnquist, Operations Manager of Resurs och Kompetens at the Karlskrona municipality’s Elderly Services Administration.
