EcoVadis: Upgrade from Bronze to Silver

Arjo has improved its EcoVadis rating from Bronze to Silver, placing the company among the top-performing companies assessed. The upgraded rating highlights Arjo's progress in environmental performance, sustainable procurement, and labor and human rights, supported by enhanced reporting, improved KPIs, more frequent reporting and external review.

CDP: Strong scores in climate and supplier engagement

In CDP's Climate Change assessment, Arjo received a **B score**, recognising robust climate-related disclosure, established governance structures, and systematic risk management and emissions reduction planning. In addition, Arjo achieved an **A score** in CDP's Supplier Engagement Assessment (SEA), highlighting its structured approach to reducing emissions across the value chain.
