The Swedish Securities Council states that the lack of organized trading in subscription rights requires prior approval

The Swedish Securities Council has today commented on Brighter's rights issue without organized subscription rights trading, which was published on November 18, 2019 (the "Benefit Issue"), and states that a rights issue without organized trading in subscription rights requires a prior approval of the Swedish Securities Council.

The Board of Directors of Brighter has, with surprise, taken part of the statement of the Swedish Securities Committee, as it is the Board's continued assessment that Brighter and its shareholders are benefited by the design of the Rights Issue.

Regarding the Benefit Issue, Brighter has had an ongoing dialogue with the Swedish Financial Supervisory Authority before the Swedish Securities Council's review, and further information regarding the Board's statement will be found in the prospectus published tomorrow, December 12, 2019.
