

## **Brighter's subsidiary Camanio wins allocation decision for stationary security alarms with KSON (The Municipal association for health care in Norrtälje)**

**Brighter AB (Publ)** announced today that its subsidiary, Camanio, has won an allocation decision with Norrtälje Municipality for stationary care alarms and alarm reception to an estimated order value of 28 MSEK. This will be Camanio's first customer within the Adda framework agreement once the parties agree on all terms in the contract. The agreement includes delivery of a digital care platform for alarm reception / management as well as hardware in the form of care alarms, sensors, and portable alarm buttons.

The tender has been processed within Addas (formerly SKL Kommentus Inköpscentral) temporary framework agreements for stationary security alarms and alarm reception with the entire alarm chain, where Camanio is one of four suppliers. In addition to the delivery of service and hardware, the agreement with Norrtälje Municipality includes training and support for all Camanio devices and hardware.

"We are thrilled to have been given the trust as a supplier to Norrtälje Municipality and for the opportunity to be part of their digitalization journey. Our digital services for elderly care aim to help security for the elderly, create more efficient way of working while trying to elevate the workload for staff and other caretakers involved in the daily care of elderly individuals. We are looking forward to building a strong collaboration and working closely with Norrtälje Municipality," comments Catharina Borgenstierna, CEO of Camanio.

"This is a huge milestone for Camanio. The company has done a brilliant job laying the foundation for and securing the tender with Norrtälje Municipality and thereby, being involved in ensuring safe care services for the municipality," stated Christer Trägårdh, Acting CEO of Brighter AB.

The agreement that will be signed runs for a period of 3 + 1 + 1 + 1 years and the value is estimated to be SEK 28 MSEK.
