# Press invitation: Children's Climate Conference 2015 Children of the world gather for climate summit in Sodertalje, Sweden

We would like to invite you to cover the Children's Climate Conference 25-28 November. 64 children from all the continents of the world will gather in Södertälje for this unique meeting. The purpose of the conference is to work together to create "the children's demands," a communiqué which will be presented to the world leaders at the climate summit COP21 in Paris.

Media are welcome to participate in the following program. Make sure to notify the press officer of your presence by Monday 23 November.

# Thursday, November 26, City Hall Södertälje

- 09.15 The children will arrive in cortege at the City Hall in Södertälje. The Södertälje councilor, Boel Godner, will personally greet each child on the "green carpet".
- 09.30 Opening Ceremony: The children will present their demands on the world's leaders and sing the conference theme song, "The Next Generation Calls", together with the singer/artist Mariette.
- 10-12 The children will sign their own communiqué which will be presented during the COP21 in Paris on 3 December.
- 12-13 Press Lunch: Representatives of the conference will present a SIFO survey that shows children's anxiety about climate change + the Swedes awareness of the COP21 meeting.
