Sweco's architects design new office park in China

Sweco Architects have won a new project for the design of Xijin Times Centre, a new area in the city of Jinan, China to be comprised of 800,000 square metres of office, hotel and commercial space. The project's value is approximately SEK 20 million for the first stage.
