



Certification of the eQart® concept has been completed with positive results

The independent certification body SGS has evaluated the eQart® concept regarding the standards necessary for the European and North American market.

The certification refers to compliance with both product, machine, and safety directives as follows:

Machinery Directive 2006/42/EC Annex I, EN ISO 12100:2010, EN 1525, EN ISO 13849-1:2015, EN 60204-1:2006+A1:2009, EN 1175-1-1998+A1-2010, ANSI C63.4, 47 CFR PART 15B

The certification refers to the modular concept eQart®, and not a specific size. The concept consists of engine modules, batteries, a control unit, and sensors which are mounted on a trolley unit built with FlexQube's patented building blocks. The certification covers eQart® sizes from 840 x 840 mm, up to 2520 x 2520 mm.
