



SBB sells 25 percent of the shares in Solon Eiendom Holding AS to OBOS

Samhällsbyggnadsbolaget i Norden AB (publ) ("SBB") and OBOS currently own Solon Eiendom Holding AS ("Solon Holding") as a jointly owned company. Solon Holding in turn owns 100 percent of the shares in Solon Eiendom AS ("Solon"). SBB is selling shares corresponding to 25 percent of the total number of shares in Solon Holding to OBOS. The deal is subject to competition approvals. The purchase price in the transaction is NOK 818.6 million.

"SBB has a strong focus on reducing its exposure in JV companies and focusing on its core business. The transaction is another step in that direction. At the same time, we are happy about our collaboration with OBOS, which is a long-term and reliable member-owned housing developer," says Krister Karlsson, Deputy CEO and Head of Projects and Property Development, Samhällsbyggnadsbolaget i Norden AB.

"We continue the work with strategic collaborations regarding the development of good and attractive housing for OBOS members. Solon is building attractive homes with high quality and exciting architecture, and as the main owner we look forward to being able to continue to develop Solon," says Ingunn Andersen Randa, Executive Vice President, responsible for equity investments at OBOS.
