GRESB (Global Real Estate Sustainability Benchmark) annually ranks the real estate sector from a sustainability perspective. In the 2025 edition of the ESG evaluation GRESB, Faberge once again achieves a top result.

With a score of 94 in the assessment relating to management and 99 in project development, Faberge receives the highest score, 5 stars, and is placed at the absolute top level in the GRESB Score as number 1 in offices, listed companies and in the Performance Score number 2 and number 3 respectively in the categories listed companies in Europe and offices Europe.
