Strong sustainability results from Cabonline, the largest taxi company in the Nordics

Cabonline is strengthening its position in sustainability. In its 2024 Sustainability Report, the company announces that 68 percent of its passenger car fleet is now independent of fossil fuels – significantly surpassing the year’s 40 percent target.

Since 2017, Cabonline has worked systematically with sustainability across three focus areas: active environment and climate action, social sustainability, and operational excellence. In 2024, the company achieved several important milestones. Cabonline became the first taxi company in Northern Europe to have its climate targets validated by the Science Based Targets initiative (SBTi). The rollout of a modern dispatch system was initiated, and by year-end, 68 percent of the fleet ran on electricity or biogas – far exceeding the 40 percent target.

“As the Nordic market leader, we have both the responsibility and the opportunity to lead the way and drive progress for the entire industry. It is encouraging to see how sustainability is integrated throughout the Cabonline organisation,” says Linda Fritzner, Chief Sustainability Officer at Cabonline.

Cabonline sustainability in brief

- 68% of the passenger car fleet is fossil fuel independent (electric or biogas). Target: 40% by end of 2024.
- Target: 100% fossil-free fleet by 2030.
- First taxi company in Northern Europe with SBTi-validated climate targets.
- Rollout of new dispatch system started – improving route optimisation, safety, and customer experience.
- Target: 100% of vehicles equipped with alcohol interlocks in Sweden, Norway and Finland.

We firmly believe that the path forward lies in maintaining a strong focus on quality and sustainability – while ensuring fair working conditions and profitability for our drivers and transporters,” says Charlotta Söderlund, CEO of Cabonline.
