The board emphasizes that the arrangements with Ms Kverneland as interim CEO and Mr Johannessen as executive chair are temporary, and that the process of recruiting a permanent CEO has a high priority.

The board will start the process of finding a permanent CEO immediately. Finding the right person may take some time, which is the reason why we have decided on this interim solution. Arne L. Norheim will take on an advisory role and will be available to the company for a shorter period of time.
