### Recent Publication: FabRICATOR for QC Applications

FabRICATOR was described in a recent paper by Merck Research Laboratories for domain characterization of therapeutic antibody products. IgG1, IgG2, IgG4 and Fcfusion proteins were investigated using FabRICATOR domain analytics.
