

Nederman invests in a new manufacturing, logistics and innovation centre in Helsingborg

The environmental technology and industrial air filtration company Nederman, founded in Helsingborg, is developing its operations in Helsingborg by investing in a new manufacturing and logistics facility as well as establishing a global innovation centre.

Nederman have production and development expertise, as well as the head office for the Nederman Group and two of its four divisions in Helsingborg. The Nederman Group today employs around 2 200 people whereof 180 are located in Helsingborg.

Together with the new manufacturing and logistics unit, the company is establishing the Nederman Innovation Hub, a company-wide innovation centre focusing on product development and innovation for improved air filtration. Competence and personnel will be added in areas such as digitalisation, mechanics, dust collection and air filtration. The Innovation Hub will be a leading meeting point for people, ideas, knowledge and creativity. The aim is to be an active facilitator of collaboration and knowledge exchange between the regions innovation-oriented companies, engineers and universities.

At the same time, Nederman will establish a new test centre to further strengthen the Group's testing capacity and position within air filtration. The investment also includes a top modern experience centre to be able to demonstrate the importance of clean air and the Group's products, solutions and IoT offering, both physically on-site, with digital display technologies and through digital online connectivity.

"I am proud to take the next step in our successful development. Nederman was founded in Helsingborg and to continue our development here is a natural step. Helsingborg has been and is a good place in which to be established and I look forward to continuing to build our world-leading position with both existing and new employees", says Sven Kristensson, CEO Nederman.

"Nederman has a long history in the city and it's very pleasing to be able to state that this world-leading environmental technology company sees Helsingborg's strength and attractiveness and chooses to invest and develop here", says Peter Danielsson, Mayor and Chairman of the Municipal Executive Committee for Helsingborg.

The lease agreement for the new purpose-built premises is for 20 years, and it is planned that Nederman will move in during summer 2024.
