

Elections and Travel Risks in 2026

Political developments can quickly affect local security conditions. In 2026, significant elections will take place in 15 countries across five continents, several of them in politically sensitive environments. To help organizations and travelers understand the potential implications, Safeture has published “Election Informer 2026” in collaboration with its intelligence partner Riskline.

The report combines political context, risk assessments, and potential travel impacts for key elections throughout the year. Its goal is to provide organizations with clear, concise insights to support safer travel planning and better risk preparedness.

Key elections with potential travel implications

The Election Informer reports on elections in 15 countries across the Americas, Europe, the Middle East and North Africa, Sub-Saharan Africa, and Asia-Pacific. Several of these events are expected to draw global attention, including the U.S. midterm elections, the Brazilian presidential election, Hungary’s parliamentary election, and elections in Libya and South Sudan.

While elections are essential to democratic processes, they can also bring periods of increased uncertainty. Demonstrations, political tensions, transportation disruptions, or temporary security measures may happen before, during, or after election day.
