US Air Force Guardian Angels is the new customer within US Department of Defense who in December 2019 selected INVISIO

We look forward to providing them with an integrated suite of specialized and tailored tactical communications systems combining both protection and efficiency," says Ray Clarke, Head of INVISIO Inc.

The Guardian Angels have conducted over 12,000 lifesaving, combat rescue missions since 2001. Additionally, because of their unique capabilities, they have been called upon to lead the rescue of over 5,000 civilians worldwide from serious natural disasters.
