Sustainalytics assessed our ESG risk exposure across key areas such as stakeholder governance, human capital, and product governance. In all these categories, Heimstaden Bostad was rated as a negligible risk contributor. Our management score of 65.9 (Strong) further highlights the depth and maturity of our ESG programmes—from green building initiatives to social supplier standards.
