

This document describes the technical platform of Information from your company and how to integrate it into the client web site.

3 System platform

3.1 Technical system overview



3.2 Software

The Information from your company is a web application which resides on Windows IIS. Its platform and client pages are written in C#.NET.

The data layer is implemented in Microsoft SQL Server with XML web services. Published web pages are presented with ASP.NET in HTML.

4 Client side integration

4.1 XML

The "Information from your Company"-module is available through XML. The XML comes in two parts, one feed part and one detail part. The feed part presents one or many items in an abbreviated version. The detail part presents one item in full detail.

Both parts are described in the following sections.

4.1.1 XML feed

The XML feed is reached by using an URL.

 http://publish.ne.cision.com/Release/[sorting type]/?feedUniqueIdentifier=[UniqueIdentifier]

4.1.1.1 XML feed - Sorting types

There are two sorting types available for use.

List Releases Sorted By Publish Date

List the releases in date order, showing the latest published release first.

${\bf List Releases Sorted By Last Change Date}$

List the releases in date order, showing the latest changed release first.

4.1.1.2 XML feed - Parameters

The URL takes the following parameters, note that they are case sensitive:

feedUniqueIdentifier (required)

Used by the system to retrieve the correct release list. The identifiers are provided by Cision on delivery of the module. This is the only required parameter.

startDate (optional)

Defines the start date of the date interval the press releases and/or reports are collected from. The format is 2001-01-01. See also: endDate.

endDate (optional)

Defines the end date of the date interval the press releases and/or reports are collected from. The format is 2001-01-01. See also: startDate.

pageSize (optional)

Defines the number of releases that are listed, the default is 50 and the max is 100. Use this parameter together with pageIndex to step/page through releases.

pageIndex (optional)

Defines what index the release list starts on. This is used together with pageSize to step/page through releases. The default is 1.

tags (optional)

Defines a filter on tags, this will return releases with these tags. One or several tags can be provided separated with a comma.

4.1.1.3 XML feed - Entities

These are the entities which the XML feed contains. Please notice that these entities can be extended upon releases of new XML feed versions from Cision (entities are though never removed).

Releases

The start element of the block containing the releases, it contains the metadata of the fetched release list and has the following attributes.

xsi:schemaLocation – This URL links to the schema that provides location information about the XML structure.

PageIndex - Displays the page index set in the URL parameter pageIndex.

PageSize – Displays the page size set in the URL parameter pageSize.

TotalHits - Total number of items in the feed.

SearchTime - Total time (ms) amount for the request.

Release

The start element of the block containing a single release, it contains the metadata of the release and has the following attributes.

Id – The id of the release.

InformationType – The type code of the release. See Appendix A for a list of types.

PublishDateUtc – The date when the release was published. It uses the UTC time standard.

LastChangeDateUtc – The date when the release was last changed. It uses the UTC time standard.

LanguageCode - The language code of the release.

CountryCode – The country linked to this release.

SenderIdentifier

The unique identifier of the sender.

SenderSystemIdentifier

The unique system identifier of the sender.

SyndicatedUrl

Used by search engines to prevent duplicate content. Also known as canonical url.

SeOrganizationNumber

Indicates whether the organization/company has a Swedish organization number or not.

SourceName

Indicates what company the release was sent from.

SourceIsListed

Indicates whether the source/company is listed or not (true/false).

IptcCode

The Iptc code refers to the SourceName.

CustomerReference

Title

The title of the release.

Intro

The preamble of the release.

LanguageVersions

The start element of the block containing language versions. This should be used of you have multiple language on your webpage and you need to be able to link releases to each other.

Version

LanguageCode - The language code of the release.

CommonID - The common id of the release when using language versions.

Categories

The start element of the block containing categories.

Category

The start element of a single category.

Name

The name of the category.

Code

The code of the category.

Keywords

The start element of the block containing keywords. Keywords are Cisions version of tags.

Keyword

The start element of a single keyword.

Value

The value of the keyword item.

Images

The start element of the block containing attached images.

Image

The start element containing a single image and has the following attribute.

CreatedDateUtc – The date the image was created. It uses the UTC time standard.

Title

The title of the image.

Description

Description of the image.

HighQualityUrl

URL to a high quality version of the image.

LowQualityUrl

URL to a low quality version of the image.

ThumbnailUrl

URL to a thumbnail of the image.

FileName

Name of the image when it is uploaded.

Videos

The start element of the block containing attached videos.

Video

The start element of a single video and has the following attributes.

Height – The height of the video.

Width - The width of the video.

CreatedDateUtc - The date the video was created. It uses the UTC time standard.

Title

The title of the video.

Description

The description of the video.

PlayerUrl

The URL to the player of the video. See Appendix B for how to display a video player properly.

ThumbnailUrl

The URL to a thumbnail of the video.

Files

The start element of the block containing attached files.

File

The start element of a single file and has the following attributes.

CreatedDateUtc - The date the file was created. It uses the UTC time standard.

Title

The title of the file.

Description

The description of the file.

FileName

The filename of the file.

Url

The URL of the file.

IsMain

Can be assigned as True/False. If the value is true then the attachment is a PDF version of the release content.

Quotes

The start element of the block containing quotes.

Quote

The start element of a single quote about the company.

QuickFacts

The start element of the block containing quick facts.

QuickFact

The start element of a single quick fact about the release or company.

External Links

The start element of the block containing external links.

ExternalLink

The start element of a single external link related to the company or the release.

SocialMediaPitch

The element containing the text that appears when sharing a release on social networks.
