Stayble is a clinical stage pharmaceutical company developing the injection treatment STA363 for disc-related low back pain. The treatment is aimed at patients whose back pain persists after physiotherapy and painkillers. The injection is given once, and the effect is expected to remain throughout the entirety of the patient's life and to require minimal rehabilitation. The Company is now focusing on the continued clinical development and is currently conducting a clinical phase 2b study.
