NCC to refurbish 303 residential units for BO-VEST in Copenhagen

NCC has been contracted by BO-VEST and Vridsløselille Andelsboligforening to refurbish 303 residential units in the Blokland area of Albertslund on the outskirts of Copenhagen in Denmark. The order value is approximately SEK 440 million.

The refurbishment includes new façades, the replacement of doors and windows, and a new roof structure with new roofing. The contract also includes refurbishing and amalgamating residential units, and building new units on the roofs of the buildings. In addition, the installations in the buildings will largely be replaced.

“I am happy about this partnership, where we will be working together to convert the area and turn Blokland into an appealing residential area with a broad housing mix. I am also gratified by the fact that we are giving the residents new façades, doors and windows that insulate and reduce heating costs in the midst of an energy crisis,” says Kristian Overby, Senior Project Manager for BO-VEST.

Blokland will be refurbished in five phases, divided between the four building sections to be refurbished and remodeled – A, B, C and F. Some of the residents will remain in their apartments while the work is ongoing.

“NCC has completed several residential refurbishments for BO-VEST and we are looking forward yet another project. We have previously refurbished the Albertslund Syd area, which was delivered six months ahead of schedule. This project requires care and a great deal of consideration since our worksite will also be people’s homes,” says Catarina Molén-Runnäs, Head of NCC Building Nordics.

The work will commence in spring 2023 and is scheduled for completion in spring 2024.

The order value of about SEK 440 million will be registered during the first quarter of 2023 in the NCC Building Nordics business area.
