The initiative has supported the coordination of targeted multinational operations, led to multiple arrests, and most significantly – contributed to the rescue of children from ongoing sexual abuse.

"Combining CRC's Artemis data with MSAB's forensic tools provides investigators with a clearer path to identifying both victims and offenders," says Greg Schiller, CEO of Child Rescue Coalition. "This collaboration enhances law enforcement's ability to build strong cases and prevent further harm."

The partnership is based on a shared objective to provide investigative teams with the tools and support required to address complex digital crime, while ensuring that cases involving identified victims remain a key area of focus.
