Einride Partners With Texas Highway Operator to Create Autonomous Freight Testbed

Strategic collaboration focuses on State Highway 130 corridor connecting Austin and San Antonio

STOCKHOLM, SWEDEN & AUSTIN, TX – Einride (“Einride” or the “Company”), a technology company driving the transition to cost-efficient electric and autonomous freight operations for some of the world’s largest shippers, today announced it has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with SH 130 Concession Company to position SH 130, which connects Austin and San Antonio, as the preferred corridor for autonomous freight operations in Texas.

Einride is the first autonomous truck company to partner with SH 130 Concession Company in this initiative. The collaboration will establish an infrastructure-ready testbed for Einride’s purpose built, cab-less autonomous freight vehicles. It will support the safety validation of autonomous highway operations on Segments 5 and 6 of SH 130, including integration with adjacent frontage roads to enable seamless first- and last-mile connectivity and to optimize vehicle performance and energy efficiency.

“This partnership with SH 130 Concession Company marks an important step forward in proving the scalability and economic benefits of electric and autonomous freight,” said Roozbeh Charli, Chief Executive Officer of Einride. “By establishing this testbed, Einride is further cementing Austin, Texas as a hub for our American autonomous freight operations, collaborating with infrastructure operators and regulators to scale safe, performance-based deployments.”

With its Freight-Capacity-as-a-Service business model, Einride combines autonomous and electric trucks, AI optimization software, and charging infrastructure into one integrated solution that delivers reliability and scale. The Company operates one of the world’s largest electric heavy-duty fleets, serving customers across the U.S., Europe and the Middle East, with autonomous trucks in daily operations with customers in both the U.S and in Europe. Einride’s safety framework has undergone independent audit and aligns with internationally recognized safety and cybersecurity standards.

SH 130 Concession Company manages and operates the 41-mile southern section of the SH 130 toll road that serves as a reliable alternative to I-35, the main U.S. freight artery connecting Mexico to Canada. Providing a strategic route for fleets to move freight reliably through the fast-growing Central Texas region, the southern section of SH 130 continues to offer ample capacity to accommodate future traffic growth. For Einride, the partnership represents a natural expansion opportunity.

Einride and SH 130 Concession Company also plan to draft a blueprint for a next-generation rest stop designed to manage electric autonomous trucks, incorporating high-capacity EV charging and specialized docking requirements. The two companies will also investigate the technical feasibility of integrating Einride’s AI-powered optimization software, Saga AI, with SH 130 Concession Company’s digital ecosystem to enhance data sharing, traffic management, and operational efficiency.

“We’re proud to partner with Einride to advance our goal to make SH 130 the premier smart freight corridor in the state,” said SH 130 Concession Company CEO, Ananth Prasad. “We’re actively working with freight customers, industry partners and TxDOT to implement new technology solutions and by aligning digital infrastructure, connectivity readiness, and future charging capacity, SH 130 Concession Company is advancing its ambition to establish the roadway as a nationally recognized route for autonomous freight movement.”

In late 2025, Einride announced plans to pursue a public listing on the New York Stock Exchange through a proposed business combination with Legato Merger Corp. III (NYSEAMERICAN: LEGT), a special purpose acquisition company. The Company has established strong commercial traction, with more than 25 enterprise customers across seven countries, approximately \$65 million in expected annual recurring revenue (ARR) from signed customer contracts, and over \$800 million in potential long-term ARR through joint business plans with blue-chip customers.

Founded in 2016, Einride is a technology company that develops and operates digital, electric and autonomous freight solutions to accelerate the transition to future proofed transportation in a cost-efficient way. Its technology platform includes AI powered planning and optimization, autonomous technologies, one of the world’s largest electric heavy-duty fleets and charging infrastructure. Einride is serving customers across North America, Europe and the Middle East.

On November 12, 2025, Einride and Legato announced they had entered into a definitive business combination agreement for a proposed business combination that would result in Einride becoming a NYSE-listed public company. The Transaction was unanimously approved by the Boards of Directors of Legato and Einride. Completion of the Transaction is anticipated to occur in the first half of 2026 subject to customary closing conditions, including regulatory approvals.
