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# Three Executive Car wins in three years for Volvo in the Car Dealer Used Car Awards

- Volvo V60 mid-size estate crowned Used Executive Car of the Year in Car Dealer's Used Car Awards 2021
- Latest honour follows the success of the V90 estate and S90 saloon in the same category in 2019 and 2020 respectively

Volvo has extended its run of success in the Car Dealer Used Car Awards with the V60 mid-size estate becoming its third different model in three years to win the Used Executive Car of the Year title. Announcing the award at a ceremony in London, broadcaster and used car expert Mike Brewer said: "The V60 offers a huge amount to used car buyers, with class-leading space, a huge boot and beautiful materials in the cabin. I love the V60 and have no doubt used car buyers will, too."

The V60 benefits from a Volvo estate car heritage of more than 60 years, ensuring supreme practicality and convenience, together with features that dovetail perfectly with modern lifestyle requirements. The load area can be increased from 519 litres (with the rear seats in place, loaded to the window line) to a vast 1,431 litres (with the rear seats folded, loaded to the roof). If more load-carrying capacity is required, braked trailers up to two tonnes can be towed (according to powertrain). The V60's essential usefulness is seamlessly blended with the latest technologies for connectivity, infotainment, driver-assistance and safety, together with Volvo's cool, contemporary Scandinavian design.

David Chesterman, Volvo Selekt Programme Manager, said: "The success of three different models in three years in the used executive car category is a testament to the lasting quality and appeal of our brand. Customers for pre-owned cars need reassurance that they are buying wisely, choosing cars that won't incur unexpected costs in the years ahead. By choosing a Volvo and making use of the Volvo Selekt programme, they can be guaranteed of sourcing the best quality cars with the security of Volvo's detailed checks and standards, and extensive warranty protection."
