

Terranor wins SEK 33 million contract for road maintenance and traffic flow improvements in Stockholm

Terranor AB, has won a two-year contract with the Swedish Transport Administration, running from 1 March 2026 to 28 February 2028. The agreement is valued at SEK 33.4 million for the full contract period and has an option for a further two years. The contract covers drainage work and minor maintenance on or adjacent to the road network in the area, as well as trimming, remedial and preventive measures for traffic flows in southern Stockholm.

“We are delighted that the Swedish Transport Administration has entrusted us with carrying out road operation measures in southern Stockholm. We are really looking forward to continuing our collaboration and improving the road safety and ensuring smooth traffic flows in Järna, Södertörn and Värmdö.”, says Henrik Jonsson, Area Manager for Area Middle.

In accordance with customary procurement procedures, a mandatory standstill period of ten days will apply before the contract can be formally signed.
