Top Ranked Brokers

The Main thing in the Brokers Market was the merger of DNB and Carnegie which strengthens their joint top position as number one in the Research Market.

SEB Equity Research - led by Erik Golrang and led ABG Sundal Collier by Sten Gustavsson

3rd place

Danske Bank - led by Björn Enarsson, Handelsbanken - led by Mattias Sundling and Nordea - led by Agnieszka Vilela

4th place

Kepler Cheuvreux - led by Maths Liljedal and Pareto - led by Stefan Wård

5th place

shared by Inderes and Redeye both acting mainly in commission research.

This survey is the 29th consecutive annual ranking of financial analysts and journalists working in the financial sector in Sweden. The survey respondents include Sweden's main institutional investors and listed companies. The number of respondents in each category as well as the response rate are shown in the description of each survey.

Ranking professionals can be a very sensitive matter. The presentation of the methodology used in the survey is therefore as open and transparent as possible. The trust of all the parties involved is a cornerstone of the survey, and the methods it uses must be credible. This ranking has become a benchmark for the financial industry in Sweden.

Ranking financial analysts is nothing new, and most developed financial markets measure how analysts perform. In Sweden however, it was unusual to rank journalists and the media 29 years ago. We have chosen to do so from the perspective of financial analysts, investors and senior corporate executives.
