The 11.6" F110 Windows tablet, certified to MIL-STD 810G, has been modified to integrate a CESSG-certified secure 2.5", 7mm Solid State Disk (SSD). The modification allows the tablet to store, process and protect classified data at levels up to and including Top Secret. The small form factor, coupled with the secure SSD, means true mobility for end users working with highly classified data, while in critical working environments.
