



Estonian Paf player wins major European poker tournament

On 17 April, Estonian Paf player Priit Brikker won the Grand Live Marbella 2014 in Spain. The winner took home a sum of 37,090 euros in the prestigious poker tournament.

A total of 162 poker players from all around the world participated in the Grand Live Marbella poker tournament, hosted by the Casino Marbella between 14 and 17 April. The Åland-based gaming company Paf was represented by 27 participants, who had qualified for the tournament through satellite tournaments at Paf.com.

In addition to first place, Priit also won Paf's very own Last Longest Bet, since he was the Paf player who was playing in the tournament longest. After his victory in the Grand Live Marbella final, 29-year-old Priit Brikker is ranked among the top ten poker tournament players in Estonia.
