Peab builds school in Lund

Peab has been commissioned to build a school for grades 4 to 6 with a sports facility, a district library, a meeting place for seniors and a culture school in Lund. The customer is Lund Municipality and the contract is worth SEK 374 million.

The building will be located at Norra Fäladen in Lund. The total area is 10,800 m² and spread over three floors. The building will be constructed according to Miljöbyggnad Silver.

"This is an important investment for the future of the residents of Lund and we're proud to be able to contribute with our knowledge. For us as community builders, this is a very important project – for the future education and development of our children and young people. What we build today will be where the next generation can grow and develop," says Marcus Emanuel, Region Manager Peab.

The existing school will be demolished in stages. Since school activities will continue in the current premises, the demolished sections will be replaced with temporary pavilions during construction.

This construction contract was preceded by a so-called phase 1 agreement where Peab was contracted to work with the customer to find an optimized product with the right quality and to manage risks and uncertainties. The project is now entering phase 2, which entails signing a construction contract.

The project is a turnkey contract in partnering. Work will start in the summer of 2026 and is expected to be completed in the summer of 2029.

The project will be order registered in the first quarter 2026.
