## Nytida starts construction of new housing in Mariefred

**Next week, the construction starts of Ambea's subsidiary Nytida's new housing at Slottsbrinken in Mariefred. Builder is Bällstaudde Projektutveckling AB and the housing with six apartments will be ready approximately by February 2018.**

The housing is intended for people with neuropsychiatric diagnoses like autism and Asperger syndrome. It will be situated in a quiet area, with a large garden. The residents will have access to common areas and there will be a separate apartment for the staff.
