Contract awards in Arizona

Opus subsidiary Gordon-Darby has been awarded a new four-year contract to run the centralized emission testing program in Arizona as well as a new emissions Remote Sensing pilot.

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) and Gordon-Darby have signed a new four-year contract for the state's centralized emissions testing program, with a possible further extension period.

Gordon-Darby has also been awarded a new contract to pilot Opus' emissions remote sensing technology in the state.

In Arizona, approximately 1.6 million vehicles are inspected every year at 18 centralized inspection stations.

Bob Tefft, President of Gordon-Darby said, "We are thrilled to be able to continue our longstanding partnership with the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality and are looking forward to advancing new technologies and features into the vehicle inspection program over the coming years."

Opus had approximately SEK 2.7 billion in revenues in 2019 with solid operating profit and cash flow. Opus has 36 regional offices, 26 of which are in the United States and the others in Sweden, Argentina, Chile, Mexico, Peru, Pakistan, United Kingdom, Spain and Australia. Opus has production facilities in the U.S. in Hartford, Ann Arbor and Tucson. The shares of Opus Group are listed on Nasdaq Stockholm.
