The <u>Annual Report</u> summarises MTG's financial performance in 2017 and reviews the company's ongoing strategic transformation from a traditional national broadcaster into a global digital entertainer. The report is available in Swedish and in English.

The <u>Corporate Responsibility Report</u> presents MTG's performance as a responsible and sustainable business. It highlights MTG's reinforcement of its corporate responsibility strategy with four focus areas – media responsibility, social impact, business ethics and environmental care – and outlines the company's sustainability priorities for the coming years.
