

Popular Boqueria choses Avenyn and Götaplatsen

Early next year, popular Boqueria will come to Gothenburg and Avenyn. In early March, the owner Napolyon Sürer and gastronomic leader Fredrik Larsson, who among other things previously led the Swedish National Culinary Team, will open the doors to Boqueria Gothenburg. Here tapas, pintxos and delicacies from Spanish food culture will be on the menu.

“It feels really great that Boqueria will establish with us on Avenyn and help to further strengthen the strong offering here with their concept. We are actively working to create an attractive meeting place on Avenyn featuring a high quality range of fashion, food, art and experiences,” says Marina Fritsche, Vice CEO and Regional Director of Wallenstam in Gothenburg.

Boqueria Stockholm, which opened its doors in 2012, is a highly regarded Spanish restaurant and guests will partly recognize the concept but it will be a completely different experience here in Gothenburg. In addition to Spanish food culture, guests will also be able to experience a really cool place offering a unique atmosphere on Gothenburg’s most fashionable street.

“We are really looking forward to opening on Götaplatsen and Avenyn. Our concept is quite unique, and we hope to introduce our interpretation of Spanish cuisine in a positive way. Boqueria is a popular and lively restaurant and we intend to adapt the design to local tastes and needs,” says Fredrik Larsson, gastronomic leader.

The menu will be created by Fredrik Larsson, who among other things previously led the Swedish National Culinary Team and worked at Le Taillevent in Paris. The restaurant will be open between early afternoon and late evening and will focus on its own interpretation of tapas and pintxos – Spanish small dishes. Now in December the owner is also opening Boqueria in Åre, the Swedish ski resort.
