Rejlers wins assignment when The Swedish Transport Administration expands the railway in Sundbyberg

Rejlers has been commissioned by the Swedish Transport Administration to design a temporary railway station in Sundbyberg. The assignment is part of the mälarbanan project, the Swedish Transport Administration's efforts to expand the railway between Tomtebodavägen and Kallhäll. A railway tunnel is planned under central Sundbyberg to make way for more green areas and promenades in the city and the temporary railway station will be important for maintaining traffic and service.

The design includes the construction of a temporary railway station, in order to meet requirements in connection with the Swedish Transport Administration's expansion of the railway, from two tracks to four between Tomtebodavägen and Kallhäll. The design includes that the station is available and in operation while the railway tunnel in Sundbyberg is being built. Rejlers' assignments include the development of software, system and building documents, as well as responsible for technical investigation and documentation. The mission will begin immediately and is expected to be completed on October 1, 2023.

"We are pleased with the confidence from the Swedish Transport Administration and look forward to contributing to the development of society in Sundbyberg. The temporary station makes it possible to maintain good infrastructure even during the expansion.
