Rejlers wins assignment for GlobalConnect

Rejlers has won the assignment to participate in the migration of agreements, networks and customers for the fiber network supplier GlobalConnect. The assignment is part of GlobalConnect's acquisition of the communications operator Open Universe and Telenor Sweden's SDU fiber assets from Telenor Sweden.

"We are pleased to help GlobalConnect with this acquisition, which is one of the largest in the industry. We have both the knowledge and capacity to take on the migration of data through smart digital solutions, which is an important part of the integration of the companies," says Niklas Siljeblad, Head of Division Communication & Security at Rejlers.

Rejlers will staff the project with several different teams in areas such as project management, networking technology and documentation. The assignment is expected to last 18 months.
