Rejlers awarded EcoVadis Gold Medal with improved sustainability score

EcoVadis is a leading independent evaluator of corporate sustainability, assessing companies across 21 criteria in four key areas: Environment, Labour & Human Rights, Ethics, and Sustainable Procurement. Its methodology is based on globally recognised standards, including the UN Global Compact's Ten Principles, the International Labour Organization (ILO) conventions, the Global Reporting Initiative (GRI) and the ISO 26000 standard.

"Improving our score from 84 to 87 is a strong acknowledgement of the progress we continue to make. Sustainability is an integral part of our strategy and of how we operate as a company. This result reflects the commitment across Rejlers to continuously raise our ambitions and create long-term value for our clients and society," says Viktor Svensson, President and CEO of Rejlers.

EcoVadis medals are based on a company's percentile ranking among all companies assessed during the previous 12 months. Rejlers' Gold Medal recognises the company as being among the top 5% globally and reflects the quality of its sustainability management system and commitment to transparency throughout the value chain.
