A reward of 10,000 Euro has today been issued by Kosta Boda for finding a stolen Bertil Vallien glass boat, taken during the Ambiente exhibition in 2013.

One of the world's leading glass designers Mr. Bertil Vallien will once again attend the Ambiente exhibition in Frankfurt, 13th -15th of February, with a brand new art glass exhibition for Kosta Boda, "an Armada of Glass". Bertil Vallien is one of the world's most renowned glass artists and glass designers, numerous awards, and is well represented in prominent museums worldwide*.

At the Ambiente exhibition in 2013 a unique glass boat at a value exceeding 50,000 Euro was stolen from the Kosta Boda stand at the very last hour of the exhibition. German police and Messe Frankfurt have been unable to find any leads to the stolen glass boat and to the very grief of Bertil Vallien and Kosta Boda. Any leads that result in the return of the boat with article number 7530769 will be rewarded 10,000 Euro.

During the following hours Kosta Boda proudly present Bertil Vallien and his new art glass exhibition at Ambiente, "an Armada of Glass", in the stand 4.0 A08.
