Avnet Services, based in Phoenix, performed the appraisal of a variety of projects including Honeywell Experion<sup>®</sup> Process Knowledge System, used in oil refineries and manufacturing facilities, and Honeywell Enterprise Buildings Integrator, used to bring together existing building systems, providing seamless digital information and control across all building operational
