



Bravida Finland provides installation of technical systems at the Hitachi Energy Park production and technology centre

Bravida Finland has been awarded contracts to supply all technical building systems for Hitachi Energy's new 40,000 square metre production and technology centre in Korsholm, Western Finland.

This new centre will include a special transformer factory, as well as production, testing and office premises for professionals of substation and electrification projects, automation and software development and support functions. Bravida is responsible for the installation of technical building systems in the industrial part of the plant covering all technical systems, including the sprinkler and fire safety systems. Bravida has been contracted by the main contractor in the project, YIT.
