Experience the East Village Like a Local

Conveniently accessible by the 4, 5, 6, F, L, N, Q and R subway lines, the East Village is a must-visit destination. As part of the neighborhood promotion, the East Village is highlighted in the documentary series NYC&GO Insider Guides, featuring locals who recommend shops, restaurants and attractions that make the East Village distinctive. The documentary and the following places, venues and more are recommended by neighborhood insiders and featured on nycgo.com/insiderguides.

- **Historic Sites:** Through the years, the East Village has seen significant transformations, and visitors and New Yorkers can learn about its past at **Merchant's House Museum**, a National Historic Landmark and the only 19th-century home in NYC in which both the interiors and exteriors have been preserved, or at **St. Mark's Church-in-the Bowery**, a Georgian-style church built in 1799.
- **Nightlife:** There is no shortage of bars, music venues and clubs in the high-energy East Village. Recommendations include **Bowery Electric**, **Manitoba's**, **Pyramid Club** and **Webster Hall**.

- **Restaurants and Cafés:** From burgers and oysters at **Black Market** to pasta and pizza at **Lil' Frankies** to ramen and fried chicken at **Momofuku Noodle Bar**, there are several delicious eats in the East Village. Insider favorites also include the pioneering vegan restaurant **Angelica Kitchen**; **Café Mogador**, a Moroccan and Mediterranean restaurant that opened in 1983; **Veniero's Pastry**, a New York City institution, serves over 200 types of Italian baked goods; and **Veselka**, a 24-hour, 60-year-old Ukrainian restaurant.
- **Shops:** For punk-rock styles, **Trash and Vaudeville** carries leather, studs, animal prints, chains and platform shoes and **Screaming Mimi's** offers one-of-a-kind vintage clothes and accessories. Another neighborhood favorite, **St. Mark's Bookshop** is an independent store that also hosts reading series.
- **Theater and Entertainment:** The East Village is home to a wide range of theater and entertainment, including low-cost comedy shows at **UCB East**, unique Off-Broadway performances like **Blue Man Group** and **STOMP**, and productions from the classics to experiential pieces at **The Public Theater**.

Stay near the neighborhood's attractions at the **Hyatt Union Square**, a vibrant hotel with 178 luxe guest rooms and suites; the **GEM Hotel SoHo**, an intimate boutique hotel, which provides guests with a complimentary iPod walking tour; or the **Sixty LES**, a luxury lifestyle hotel, home to 141 spacious guest rooms and an array of dining options. Also nearby, the **W New York Union Square** is a contemporary 270-room hotel located in a glamorous Beaux-Arts building, and the full-service **Holiday Inn Lower East Side** provides high-speed Internet and an on-site restaurant.
