This architecture enables a controlled and auditable process for deferred settlement, supporting both security and scalability in offline scenarios.

*"Offline capability is not a feature. It is a requirement for any robust digital money system," said **Joachim Samuelsson, CEO of Crunchfish.** "The question is no longer if digital money should work offline, but how to implement it in a bankable, implementable, and governed way."*
