The company has been selected from a global field as one of only two finalists in the [Established Trendsetter category of the Discover Perfect Pitch competition](#). On Wednesday, September 30, Crunchfish CEO Joachim Samuelsson will take to the Discover Stage to pitch how Governed Offline Payments addresses financial inclusion, payment resilience and systemic risk.

Throughout Sibos, Joachim Samuelsson and Gagan Kochar will be available at booth DISS40 to demonstrate the technology and discuss how Governed Offline can be integrated with existing payment infrastructure.
