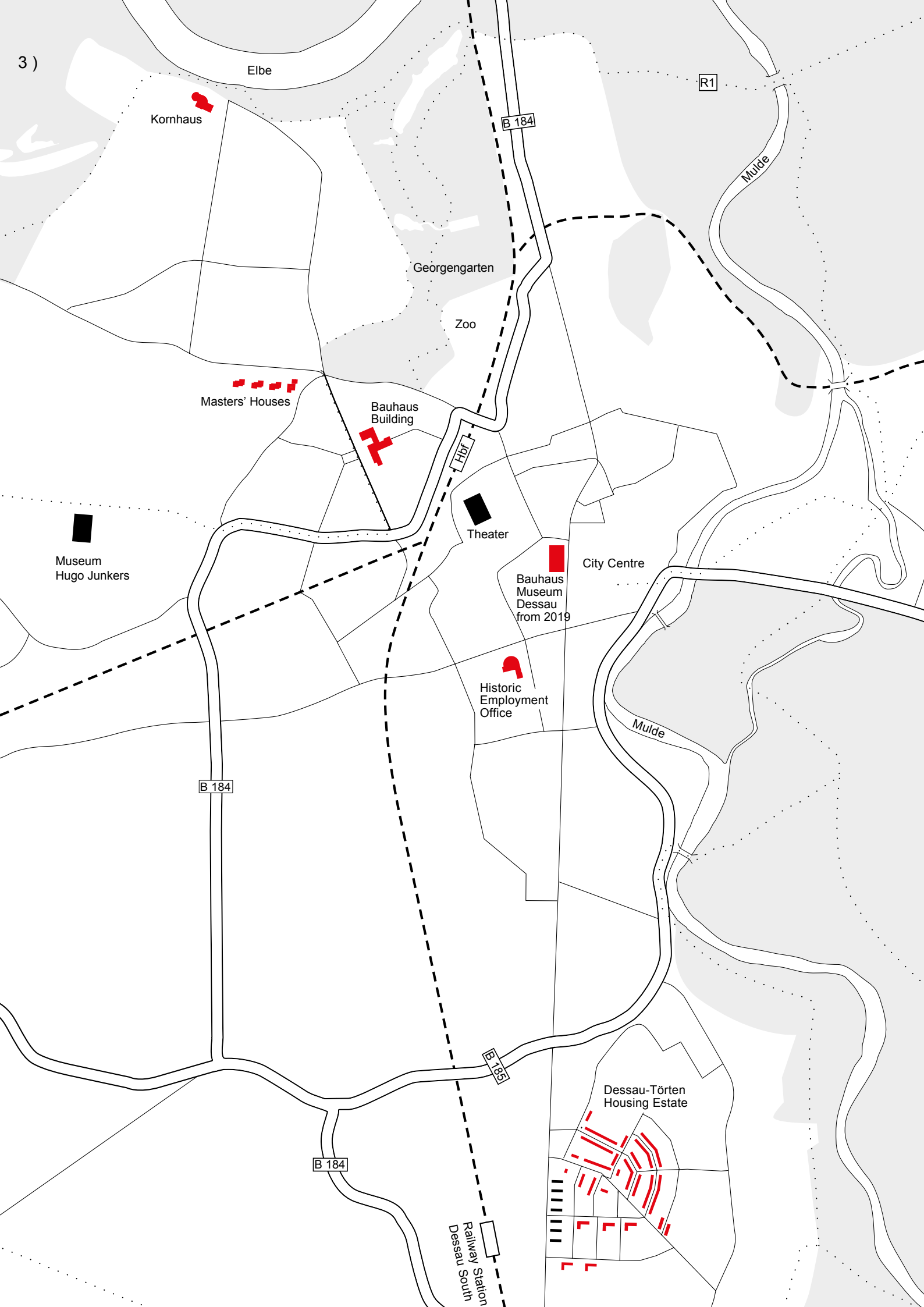
The Bauhaus in Dessau presents a unique opportunity to delve into the Bauhaus culture.

Dessau is the city most closely associated with the Bauhaus. This is where the school of design founded by Walter Gropius in Weimar in 1919 was active for the longest period of time, and where it experienced its heyday from 1925 to 1932. All three directors of the Bauhaus – Walter Gropius, Hannes Meyer and Ludwig Mies van der Rohe – lived and worked in Dessau. And virtually all the Bauhaus buildings that were built in Dessau can still be visited today.

In 2019 the Bauhaus Museum Dessau will open its doors to commemorate the centenary of the Bauhaus. The collection of the Bauhaus Dessau Foundation, the second-largest Bauhaus collection worldwide, will be shown here for the first time to its fullest extent. The museum will simultaneously offer space for the exploration of the themes and discourses of the Bauhaus in the 21st century.

The Bauhaus in Dessau has been a UNESCO World Heritage site since 1996.

Bauhaus Buildings Dessau

Most of the original Bauhaus buildings, virtually all of which are regarded as modernist icons, are found in Dessau. Every building is in itself a prototype. In addition to the Bauhaus Building and the Masters' Houses, these include the Dessau-Törten Housing Estate with the three housing types Sietö I, II and IV (1926–1928), the Steel House (1926/27), the Konsum Building (1928) and Hannes Meyer's Houses with Balcony Access (1930). Other architectural works of note in Dessau include the historic Employment Office by Walter Gropius (1929) and the Kornhaus restaurant by Carl Fieger (1930), situated by the Elbe river.

For the centenary in 2019 the Bauhaus buildings will be curated as a collective ensemble. Visitors will be able to discover the Bauhaus's experimental, radical and utopian approach to architecture as applied design for a new, modern way of living.

Bauhaus Building

The school as a place of collective, experimental learning for a holistic development of the individual. With the Bauhaus Building, constructed in 1926, Walter Gropius transposed his Bauhaus idea into architecture. The workshops, the preliminary course room, the stage, the canteen and the Studio Building: in its architecture, the building reflects the curriculum.

Masters' Houses

The complex of Masters' Houses, built based on plans by Walter Gropius, exemplifies the avant-garde concept of living and epitomises the artists' colony of the 20th century. Walter Gropius, Oskar Schlemmer, Georg Muche, László Moholy-Nagy, Lyonel Feininger, Wassily Kandinsky and Paul Klee lived with their families in the Masters' Houses.

Dessau-Törten Housing Estate

The Dessau-Törten Housing Estate was built as an experimental development with the aim of creating affordable housing. Prototypes included Haus Anton as an example of the housing type Sietö I, the Konsum Building, the Houses with Balcony Access and the Steel House, a materials experiment of the New Architecture.

Bauhaus Museum Dessau

Opening 2019

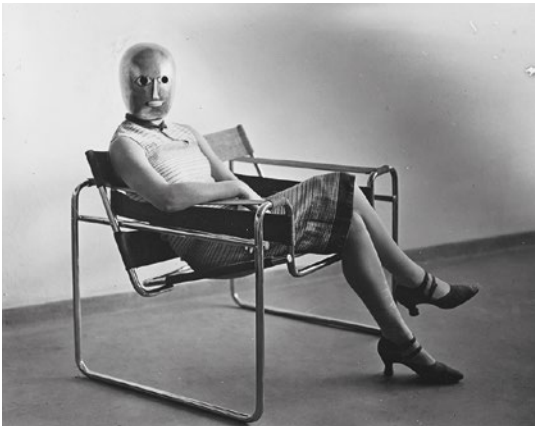
With the opening of the new Bauhaus Museum Dessau in 2019, visitors will be able to see the distinctive collection of the Bauhaus Dessau Foundation displayed for the first time to its fullest extent. The new museum in Dessau city centre will interconnect the city's historic Bauhaus buildings and set a contemporary accent with its architecture.

The concept by up-and-coming addenda architects (González Hinz Zabala) of Barcelona envisages a *Black Box* on the top floor for the historic collection, complemented by an *Open Stage* on the ground floor for contemporary statements.

The exhibition *Versuchsstätte Bauhaus. The Collection.* gives an account of the history of the Bauhaus as a school. Visitors can find out more about the Bauhaus as a UNESCO World Heritage site at the Bauhaus Museum Dessau.

worked in Dessau at the Bauhaus.

Learning and teaching, free design
and industrial prototypes, artistic ex-
periment and the demands of the mar-
ketplace – one of the specialities of the
Dessau Bauhaus collection is that its
exhibits and objects are able to tell the
story of life and work at the school of
design, which remains one of a kind
worldwide.

Utopia and everyday life: after the First
World War the Bauhauslers sought
methods of shaping and designing the
new, modern way of living. Whether
typefaces, furniture, textiles, wallpa-
pers or buildings, the modern culture
of everyday life that we take for grant-
ed today was forged in Dessau during
this period.

The exhibition takes up 1,500 square
metres and tells the story of the Bau-
haus as a place that was equally ex-
perimental and single-minded in pur-
suit of its goals both regionally and in
international networks.
